Friday 3/17 - Itinerary & Instructions

- 3:15pm School Ends. Report to band room and move equipment to arena gym.
- 3:30pm Rehearsal Begins
- 6pm Rehearsal concludes. Begin loading trucks.
- 7pm Dismissal (or whenever loading is completed!)

Saturday 3/18 - Itinerary & Instructions

- 4:00am Suggested Departure from Trussville - *please arrange carpool pickups to be on time! Remember to account for both a time change and Atlanta traffic if you are traveling from Trussville this morning.*
- 8:00am Call Time & Arrival at North Forsyth High School. Ms. Moore will send "home base" location info after she arrives. Meet and unload trucks.
- 8:45am Students change into uniform. *Makeup/Hair should be done at this time.*
- 9:15am Push to Warm Up Zone 'A'
- 9:21am Warm Up begins! Area 'A'
Any parent volunteers helping at this show report to warm up to help move ensemble.
Note: at this point anyone without a performer/staff/volunteer wristband will not be permitted to enter with the ensemble. You must purchase a ticket and be in the spectator seating.
- 8:39am Push to gym for performance
- 9:45am "on deck"
- 9:54am Prelims Performance!
- 10:10am Return to trucks, change out of uniform. Load and lock trucks.

10:45am Watch Lots/Performances/Lunch/Break and Relax time.
*All truck-loading responsibilities must be finished before watching groups! Stay in groups of 3 or more. We suggest planning on watching both lots and gym performances. The lot experience at WGI is really special, and is totally different than watching on YouTube! At the end of this itinerary is a schedule of prelims performance times, and you can estimate when people are warming up.

2:45pm All students report to Student Side of the gym. Try to all sit together!

3:30pm Exit gym as a group and head back to trucks for a meeting regarding Finals Schedule.

**At this time prelims results will be released and we will know if we made finals or not! If we make finals, continue reading this itinerary. If we do not make finals, we will dismiss students and families to travel home and give an appropriate ETA for arriving to HTHS to unload the trucks. If we make finals, our warm up time will be between 4:57-6:09pm, and we will perform between 5:30-6:15pm. We will go over the plan once we know if we made finals!*

4:57pm-6:09pm Warm Up Time Slots

5:30pm - 6:15pm Performance Time Slots

6:30pm Change out of uniform, load trucks.

7:00pm Watch Lots/Performances/Dinner/Break and Relax time. Same instructions as earlier! Until you are to report for awards you must be in the lot, or in the stands watching ensembles. Keep an eye on the time and know where you need to be. Stay in groups of 3 or more.

9:00pm All students report to Student Side of the gym. Try to all sit together! Watch Independent Open and World ensembles as a group.

10:30pm Awards Ceremony

10:50pm Awards Ends. Dismiss from stands with Ms. Moore/Mr. Adair - depart for HTHS.

1:30am ETA @ HTHS (Trussville time). Students help unload trucks before dismissal.

- Attire/Packing List:
 - o Change of clothes for the show: pants/weather appropriate attire/HHS band shirt/etc.
 - o Uniform:
 - Black Band Shoes
 - Long Black Socks
 - Any necessary undergarments for your uniform tops/bottoms. Uniforms will be loaded on the truck, students just need to make sure they have their shoes/socks/undergarments.
 - o Hair instructions will be gone over during rehearsals.
 - o Sticks/Any accessories you need for the long day.
 - o Sunscreen/Sunglasses
 - o Snacks/Food Items/Water Bottle
 - o \$\$\$: \$30 (should be enough for lunch/dinner/snacks).
 - We suggest bringing extra money for any possible souvenirs as there will be cool booths and merchandise for sale.

- Food:
 - o Please eat or pack a breakfast for the road.
 - o Students will eat lunch at the concession stand at NFHS, bring money! Please bring both cash/card options, as we are unsure what preferred method of payment the concessions booth will have.

- Transportation:

 - o Students are asked to stay through the duration of the awards ceremony. Anyone who wishes to checkout after the performance must communicate their intent prior to the contest day, and must be signed out with Ms. Moore by a parent or guardian.
 - o All students are asked to return to the school and help unload the trucks after the contest.
 - o Remember that students and parents/guardians/friends/family are representing Hewitt-Trussville at all times. Please refer to the handbook for expectations and policies for competition etiquette.
